In June 2010, UnitedHealth Group strengthened its commitment to health equity by founding **the Health Equity Services** program. In this cross-functional, enterprise-wide program leaders work across the enterprise to foster a holistic approach, first using data to identify gaps in access, care and/or outcomes and then developing tailored materials and interventions based on members' cultural beliefs and behaviors, to reduce health disparities and enhance the end-to-end consumer experience.


Overview

Working on four core areas:


- Food Insecurity
