Subject: Follow-Up Information on Behavioral Health Provided by School-Based Health Centers -

Network Adequacy Regulations

I wanted to provide follow-up information regarding our request for the Maryland Insurance Administration to recognize school-based health centers as essential community providers (ECPs). At the network adequacy meeting in December, I was asked how many school-based health centers provide behavioral health services. We requested and receive this information from the Maryland State Department of Education. Out of the eight-six school-based health centers, thirty-two provide behavioral health services. These school-based health centers are in Baltimore City, Dorchester, Howard, Montgomery, and Wicomico counties. With Maryland's focus on meeting the behavioral health needs of children, we expect that more school-based health centers will be providing behavioral health centers. This growth would be supported by inclusion of school-based health centers as ECPs.
