**RE:** Title Insurance Producer License Application Requirements Pursuant to §10-

121 of the Insurance Article, Annotated Code of Maryland

This Bulletin is to advise you that Bulletin 13-17, regarding the title insurance licensing application and approval process, is hereby rescinded.

The purpose of this Bulletin is to notify the above entities that biographical affidavits are no longer required to be submitted as part of the title business entity application process.

All applicants for a title producer license may now use the online application process via <a href="https://www.nipr.com">www.nipr.com</a> (effective 08/01/19) or submit a paper application directly to the Administration. A copy of the application forms and instructions may be found on the MIA's website at: <a href="https://insurance.maryland.gov/Producer/Pages/titleip.aspx">https://insurance.maryland.gov/Producer/Pages/titleip.aspx</a>

The Administration will continue to investigate the character of each person identified as a controlling person and each person identified as a trust money controller pursuant to § 10-121 (d)(3), of the Insurance Article, Annotated Code of Maryland.

Fidelity and surety bonds are still required to be submitted to complete the application process.
